


The UT Martin Instructional Leadership program is designed to immerse candidates in a variety of authentic instructional leadership experiences focused on what successful principals must know and be able to do. All coursework is taught by professional educators with administrative experience as a principal. The UTM Leadership Coaches who work with candidates during and after program completion are former principals who have received additional training in national coaching and mentor programs. The UT Martin Instructional Leadership program believes in the power of connection. Our program is a cohort-based model where courses are limited to no more than 15 members creating a bond among candidates as they work together in courses throughout the 30 hour program.

#### Provider Type


