## **Charge of the Committee:**

- 1. Provide leadership in the review, evaluation, and use of data for continuous improvement and accountability for student learning, the major, and department assessment plans.
- 2. Ensure consensus about what the institution expects students to represent or demonstrate along the continuum of their learning.
- Determine how to integrate data collected among individual academic colleges, the Office of Curriculum and Assessment, the Honors Program, the Office of Student Engagement, and the Paul Meek Library.
- Use the assessment results to verify student achievement and to identify patterns of strengths and weaknesses in order to improve teaching and learning.
- 5. Provide an annual report to the Assessment Oversight Committee documenting changes, strengths, and weaknesses of student learning outcomes.
- 6. Disseminate results of student learning in academic areas in order to use assessment to inform the budget process.
