Charge of the Committee:

- 1. Provide leadership in the review, evaluation, and use of data for continuous improvement and accountability for student growth and development and unit assessment plans.
- 2. Ensure consensus about what the institution expects students to represent or demonstrate along the continuum of their development.
- 3. Monitor assessment of student growth and development outcomes in areas related to student affairs, athletics, and student leadership.
- 4. Determine how to integrate data collected for continuous improvement and accountability among areas related to student affairs, athletics, and student leadership.
- 5. Use the assessment results to verify student growth and development and to identify patterns of weakness in order to improve services.
- 6. Determine how outputs in the form of products, services, and information will be received and measured by students.
- 7. Provide an annual report to the Assessment Oversight Committee documenting changes, strengths, and weaknesses of educational support services and student affairs.
- 8. Disseminate results of assessment of educational support services and student affairs in order to inform the budget process.
